



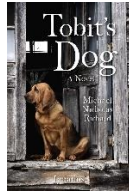

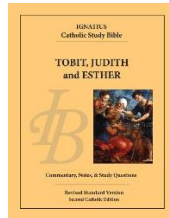

Summer Book Club: Tobit's Dog by Michael Nicholas Richard



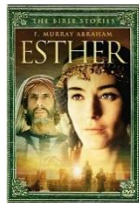

Read the book over the summer and we will meet **August 23** to discuss. A discussion guide will be provided.

This bible study leads readers through a penetrating study of the Old Testament books Tobit, Judith and Esther, using the biblical text itself and the Church's own guidelines for understanding the Bible. Ample notes accompany each page, providing fresh insights by renowned Bible teachers Scott Hahn and Curtis Mitch as well as time-tested interpretations from the Fathers of the Church. These helpful study notes provide rich historical, cultural, geographical, and theological information pertinent to the Old Testament book—information that bridges the distance between the biblical world and our own. We will read and discuss two chapters a week from **August 30 – February 21**. Discussion questions are included in the study guide.
