Attendance—**Attendance is important!!**—The Diocese of Charlotte requires that students miss no more than 6 classes in any given year in order to advance to the next grade level. During a sacramental year each child is permitted 3 absences. Should the number of absences be exceeded, we will have to consider having the child repeat the grade the following year.

Stewardship—Parent involvement is also integral in partnering with our catechetical program. Thus, we ask that each family sign up to volunteer for one of our newly formed Stewardship Teams (information can be found on the parent involvement form). Please commit to helping your child(ren) and our program in some way this year.
